*Obtaining Plenary Indulgences for the Poor Souls In Hallowtide*

General rules for obtaining a Plenary Indulgence:

1. State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act
2. Detachment from sin, even venial sin
3. Confession (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)
4. Communion (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)
5. Prayers for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)
6. Indulgenced act: a special good work with special conditions of place and time

Indulgence acts for obtaining a Plenary.

Indulgence for the Poor Souls of Purgatory:  
From November 1 to 8: visit of a cemetery with mental prayer for the poor souls.

On November 2: visit of a church or an oratory with one Our Father and one Creed being recited.
