Sitting has a mixed history in liturgy because for most of history, churches had no seats for the people. However, the clergy often did have seats, so the times they sat were adopted when pews were introduced. On the one hand, one sits when not doing anything in particular, but when it comes to Mass or even extended adoration, there is a certain receptivity involved in sitting. We receive the content of the readings, the psalm, the homily, the offertory chant. We wait to receive what the Spirit means to give us to act when the time is right.

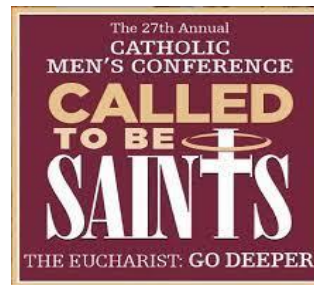

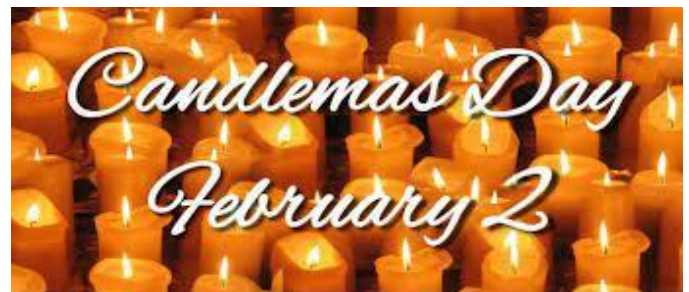

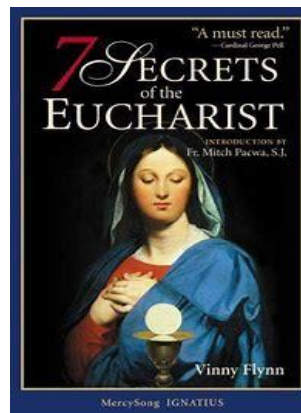
