PASTOR'S COLUMN:

Happy Palm Sunday!

We may not have all the palm branches we looked for this year, but the branches of trees and shrubs newly in leaf are actually traditional. In the south of Europe, olive branches were used, just as in Jesus' day. In England, boxwood branches were the most common. Northern climes generally didn't use palms until very recently.

Confessions will be available from 4-7 this Monday in Jackson and Zaleski. Mass and adoration will be at Holy Trinity. There is no Tuesday Mass.

I hope you will consider coming to as many of the Triduum Masses as you can—they provide a very vivid way of living out the mysteries of our redemption. They used to be holy days of obligation, but the Church restored the Masses to the evening so that people could work and still observe them, without re-imposing the obligation. Whatever you may be able to do, may God prepare your hearts for the joys of the Resurrection.
