## Pastors Column

Happy Mardi Gras! Let the good times roll! Our enjoyment of Carnival should be proportioned to the discipline of our Lent. Please recall that the Church requires Catholics 18-59 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and all Catholics age 14 and above must abstain from flesh meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. See the bulletin or fliers for the Ash Wednesday schedule.

Be ready with your plans for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Doubling prayer is a helpful rule of thumb—your own circumstances will dictate specifics. Adopt some form of selfdenial that is challenging for you. As a consortium, we have baby bottles for pregnancy centers. We will have a collection of them on Easter Sunday. But I encourage you to find individual ways of serving those in need this Lent.

### A few dates for your calendars:

Thursday, February 29 is our First Friday holy hour of reparation. Both the bishop and I strongly encourage people to take part in this holy hour to repair the damage caused by the evil of abortion in Ohio, and to grow in love of Jesus' Sacred Heart.

Saturday, March 16 will be our consortium day of adoration. Come any time from the 9 AM Mass at Ss. Peter and Paul until Benediction at 6 PM. We will have sign-ups for hours as the day approaches.

Monday, March 18 we will celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph with a Mass in Wellston at 6 PM. Tuesday, March 19 is a day to lessen your penances and celebrate—to the extent that you observe his feast. The Tuesday noon Mass at Holy Trinity will also be of the solemnity.

Monday, March 25 will have confessions available in Jackson and Zaleski from 4-7 PM. Please note that no penance service is scheduled for Lent, so you should get to confession either this day or at the regularly scheduled times.
