**Pastors Column:**

I hope your Lent is off to a good start. You may have noticed new hymn sheets starting this season (we don't have them at Holy Trinity yet). Hymns are what we are used to at Mass, but they amount to singing AT Mass rather than singing the Mass. The text in italics on the hymn sheets are called "The Proper of the Mass", meaning they belong to each particular Mass. Just like there are particular responsorial psalms to be sung at each Mass, the Church prescribes certain texts from the psalms to be sung for the entrance, offertory, and communion processions. These chants, along with the gradual and tract/alleluia (which can be done instead of the responsorial psalm), have been in about the same arrangement for nearly 1500 years, making them as much a part of our heritage as the Roman Canon itself. The Second Vatican Council gave a privileged place to plainsong melodies for these chants to be sung by the choir alone, but since we are used to hymns, this recent collection of hymn-tune paraphrases of the introits and offertories gives us a great way to adapt the Church's tradition to our situation. The melodies should be fairly familiar, so I hope that you find this a helpful way to enter the millennia-old custom of singing the psalms, God's own hymn-book, in worship.

Next week there will be a second collection to fund the schooling of seminarians. If you don't like the idea of giving money to the Diocese, you will want to be especially generous in this collection, considering that we know exactly what the money collected will go to. This collection is necessary because we ended up having far more seminarians this year than we budgeted for, and if we are serious about our commitment to fostering priestly vocations, this is a prime opportunity. Thanks to everyone for your generosity.

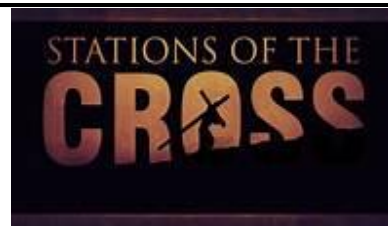
