## PASTORS COLUMN

Happy Mother's Day! Thank you to all our mothers for all you have done in nurturing and bringing up your children with love.

It is time for the Appeal 2024 for the Diocese of Columbus. Our goals are as follows: \$16,315.74 from Holy Trinity, \$15,990.32 from Sts. Peter and Paul, and \$8,005.24 from St. Sylvester. None of our parishes met their goals last year, as I am sure will not surprise you. In the past, parishes have not been penalized for failing to meet Appeal goals. This will no longer be the case. What we do not raise towards our goals this year will result in an increase of the diocesan assessment, so that a smaller percentage of our Offertory would go to our local needs. Needless to say, this would not be good for us.

Exceeding our goals, however, still has the benefit of the excess not being subjected to the assessment. For Holy Trinity, we would continue to set aside money for our facilities, for Sts. Peter and Paul, our excess will continue to pay off our debt, and for St. Sylvester, the excess will replenish the Parish Aid Fund. We have an obligation to support the operation of the whole diocese in a fair proportion, and it would be better for us to benefit in the process.
