**PASTORS COLUMN:**

Merry Christmas and Happy Epiphany!

Today's feast is the crown of the Christmas Season and the 12 Days of Christmas. In fact, traditionally, Epiphany is of a higher rank and was one of the 3 feasts of baptism, along with Easter and Pentecost. We are used to the image of the Wise Men coming from the East to see the Christ child, but the main theme of today's celebration is rooted in the manifestation of Christ to the world. The events of Jesus's Baptism and the Wedding of Cana, which also reveal the Christ, get more time in the days that follow. The antiphons of Lauds and Vespers today explain the feast to us:

At the Benedictus. Antiphon. Tone 8. This day \* the Church is joined to her heavenly Spouse, for Christ has cleansed away her crimes in the Jordan; with gifts the magi hasten to the royal nuptials, and the guests are gladdened with wine made from water, alleluia.

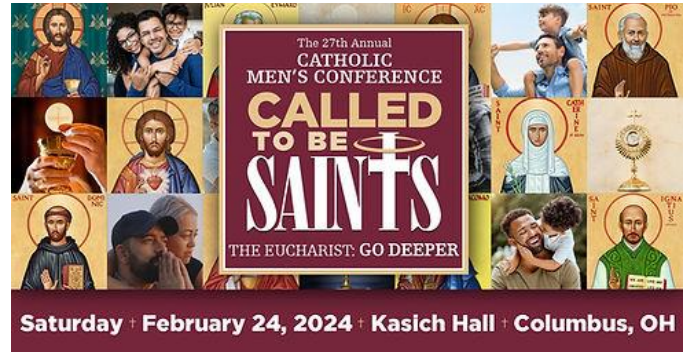
At the Magnificat. Antiphon. Tone 1. The holy day \* we are keeping is adorned with three mysteries: this day a star led the Magi to the manger; this day wine was made from water at the wedding; this day at the Jordan Christ willed to be baptized in order to save us, alleluia.

Let us rejoice that God has revealed his power through his Son, who has saved us by drawing us to him, cleansing us, transforming and uniting us to himself.

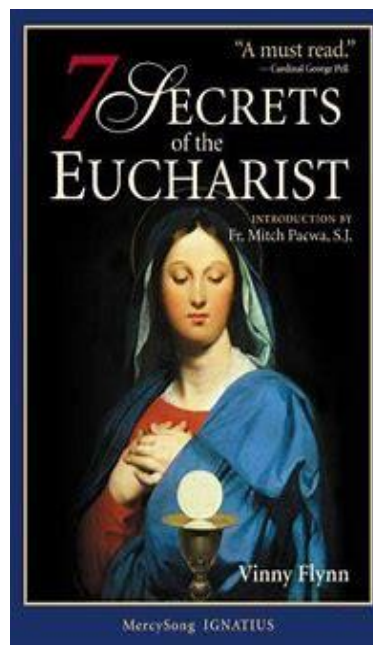
